## SUMMER RESEARCH PROGRAM JUNE 21, 2021 - JULY 30, 2021







The P.E.E.R Summer Research Program is designed for students who want to immerse themselves into biological research. It emphasizes laboratory discovery, communication of knowledge, and professional growth. A diverse group of 5-6 high school students chosen from existing Kaiser Permanente School of Medicine (KPSOM) pathway programs will participate in the Summer research program. Students in the program will be able to meet and connect with research-focused students from different backgrounds who quickly form a community of motivated scholars at the California Institute of Technology (Caltech) and KPSOM. Applicants will be chosen from competitive process and students of all backgrounds will be selected.

- \$2000 Summer Stipend
- Up to \$500 Transportation Costs
